



SKILLS FOR EMPLOYABILITY

STUDY AND WORK PROGRAMME

Based at: Lansdowne, Bournemouth

Duration: 41 weeks, can be adapted to a minimum of 25 weeks = 12 + 12 + 1 or up to 49 weeks = 24 + 24 + 1

Start Dates: This course will commence 6 times a year – details to be advised on application

Introduction: This course has been designed specifically for international students aged over 18 and the purpose of this programme is to prepare you for a career as a Manager of a restaurant or hotel. If you are successful, you can expect to gain employment in leading hotels.

Entry Requirements: You will need the following:

- to have satisfactorily completed your compulsory education
- training or experience in a hospitality industry setting
- English Language competence equivalent to Intermediate level, e.g. IELTS 4.5 or equivalent

Course Details: The programme is divided into three main areas:

- a taught programme focusing on the Hotel and Catering specialism delivered in the UK
- an English Language programme focusing on the specialist vocabulary and cultural familiarisation
- work experience in a UK hotel

Students will study in Bournemouth but then may go to other parts of the country for their work experience.

Elements of the Programme:

- a 20 week, 16 hours per week taught programme of knowledge and skills development plus 2 hours tutorial
- a 20 week work placement
- a one-week assessment and progression programme

Cost: To be confirmed depending on duration of study
